## **The Great Commission**

Jesus created the earth and the universe, and He is the owner of all creation. And since Jesus has been given all authority in heaven and on earth, He is solely qualified to be Lord over all creation and to command His people. Jesus' command to His people is to make disciples of all nations - all races, ethnicities, cultures, and people groups. Christians, while born again by the Spirit of God, are to be intentionally made into disciples. The Great Commission is not just about evangelism - it is also about discipleship. Discipleship is an involved process of teaching, training, and instruction with other Christians serving as experienced guides. Because Christ's authority is not bound by space or time, His commission for discipleship is made to Christians of every generation.
